EAA Air Academy: Discover Flight summer camp

Scholarship description and eligibility criteria

EAA Chapter 526 scholarship for a 14- to 15-year old (as of June 12, 2025) to attend EAA Discover Flight summer camp at the EAA Air Academy, June 12 - 17, 2025, at Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Applicants must reside in Placer, El Dorado, Nevada, Sacramento, or Yuba Counties. The scholarship covers full tuition, housing, and meals. Upon the scholarship awardee's return from Oshkosh and in-person presentation of his/her trip report, EAA Chapter 526 will reimburse up to \$900 in round-trip air fare to either Green Bay or Appleton from Sacramento.
